

DETAILED INFORMATION

Admission to LL.B. First Year (Three Year Course) at University Law College and University Law College Centre-II, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur. (ULET-2023)

ABOUT THE ADMISSION

Admission to LL.B. First Year (Three Year Course) for the Session 2023-24 at University Law College and University Law College Centre-II, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur, shall be made on the basis of merit of marks obtained at entrance examination i.e. ULET-2023.

TOTAL NUMBER OF SEATS

- The admission to first year of LL.B. (Three Year Course) will be done for **600 seats** [300 seats for University Law College and 300 seats for University Law College Centre-II (SFS Course)].

Explanation : As per B.C.I. Guidelines issued on 29-07-2019, 10% seats shall be reserved over and above for E.W.S. category i.e. Maximum 30 seats for each centre.

- Reservation of seats will be applicable as per the University norms as provided in University Prospectus for the Session 2023-24.

STEPWISE PROCEDURE FOR FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM

STEP I

1. The Candidates are required to **Fill the Application Form for Admission to LL.B. First Year (Three Year Course) at <http://univraj.org/ULET2023>** and complete the registration which will commence from May 30, 2023.
2. During the registration, the candidates are required to upload his/her photograph, signature, scanned copies of Mark sheets of class X, XII, U.G./P.G. (Original/Online), category certificate (if applicable), P.H. Certificate (if applicable) and Weightage Certificate i.e. NCC/NSS/Sports etc. as per University Prospectus (If applicable):

a) Photo Requirement:

- The photograph must be taken on or after 01 April, 2023.

- Don't wear a cap or goggles while getting the photograph clicked. Candidates who wear spectacles regularly can put them on.
- Computer and Polaroid generated photographs will not be accepted.
- Image Size: 20KB-50 KB
- Acceptable file formats- JPG/JPEG/BMP/PNG

Note:

- If the scanned photographs do not meet the above-mentioned criteria, the form will be rejected.
- If the photographs are found to be manipulated or digitally edited, the form will be rejected. This would be considered as use of unfair practices.
- It is mandatory to carry an additional passport size photograph (including name and date of taking the photo) to the examination centre. It will be affixed on the attendance sheet.

b) Signature Requirement:

- Upload your Signature done by Black Marker Pen
- Image size: 10KB-30 KB
- Acceptable file formats - JPG/JPEG/BMP/PNG

c) Documents Required (Scanned Copies) :

- Upload your Mark Sheets of Class X, XII, final year's marksheet of U.G. and P.G. (If applicable) (Original or online)
- Upload Latest Caste Certificate, if applicable (not issued before 01-06-2022 in case of O.B.C./M.B.C.). In case of E.W.S. candidate(s) certificate should be issued on or after 01-04-2023.
- Upload P.H. Certificate, if applicable
- Upload the Weightage Certificate i.e. NCC/NSS/Sports etc., if applicable.

Note :

In case if a candidate claims weightage he/she has to submit a hard copy of his/her original certificate in support of the claim alongwith the self attested photocopy of the same, to the office of Convener, ULET-2023 from July 1st to 04th, 2023 during office hours i.e. 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

STEP II

1. After successful registration, the candidate is required to submit the requisite application fee i.e. **Rs. 1300/- for Gen/EWS/OBC/MBC and Rs. 1100/- for S.C./S.T./P.H.** categories, online through UPI / payment gateway of ICICI Bank.
2. No other mode of payment for fee shall be accepted.

STEP III

1. After successful submission of fee, the online payment invoice will be generated.
2. **The applicants are not required to deposit the hard copy of the online application form.** However, they are advised to take the **print of the invoice and the complete application form** for their own reference and for the purpose of Counselling for admission.

Note:

- (i) The candidates are advised to check and verify the application form before final submission. Only a single chance to make change(s)[In category/ marks/ documents upload etc.] in the application form will be provided on June 26th & 27th, 2023. Incomplete forms and forms without fee payment will be rejected without any correspondence.
- (ii) Furnishing of false, wrong or inaccurate information may lead to cancellation of the test result, admission, examination for future, degree and even prosecution in appropriate cases.
- (iii) Incomplete application may be rejected and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard. The receipt of an application will not mean that application is complete.
- (iv) As per University Ordinance 81-D, 81-III and 81-IV, the Candidate(s) Claiming weightage/concession for , NCC/NSS/Sports/Differently Abled (PH) or Other category, shall have to submit the hard copy of their application form, original documents for claim of weightage/concession/ disability and self-attested photocopies of the same to the **Convenor, ULET-2023, University Law College Centre-II, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur** as per time and dates mentioned in the schedule. Under no circumstance, the hardcopy of the application form and documents for claim of weightage/concession/ disability will be accepted **after the deadline.**

ELIGIBILITY, AGE & RESERVATION

All the candidates who are applying for Admission to LL.B. First Year (Three Year Course) are advised to ensure their eligibility before filling the application form, as provided in the University Prospectus 2023-24 available on University Website.

I. Eligibility to Apply for Admission in LL.B. I Year

- (a) (i) A candidate may apply for admission to LL.B. I Year who has secured minimum 45% marks in case of General/EWS/OBC/MBC category and minimum 40% marks in case of SC/ST/PH (differently able) Category in the aggregate of the qualifying Examination (UG/PG).
- (ii) **Minimum 60% marks or above in the aggregate in case of students coming from Universities other than those situated in the State of**

Rajasthan. Minimum eligibility for admission to the LL.B. First Year (0.252)

As per provision of 0.252 only such candidates who have passed the Bachelor's or Master's Degree examination with the required marks in aggregate shall be eligible for admission to the LL.B. I year. **No concession on any ground, whatsoever, is admissible in the said rule for minimum eligibility.**

Note: *Minimum marks means excluding any concessional marks and no round off shall be allowed i.e. a single less mark in minimum eligibility will disqualify the candidature.*

- (b) **Qualifying Exam :** A candidate who has taken the Bachelor's (UG) or the Master's Degree (PG) in Arts / Commerce / Science / Engineering / Medicine / Management (of 2 years duration) / Nursing / Agriculture or the Degree of Shastri / Acharya or the Degree of Ayurvedacharya / Ayurveda Brihaspati of this University or of any other University recognised for the purpose by the Syndicate with full course prescribed for the Degree.

Explanation: *candidate(s) who have appeared in the Final year of qualifying exam are eligible to apply for the admission to LL.B. First Year subject to submission of their Mark-sheet of qualifying examination till the last date provided for making correction(s) in the application form i.e. June 27, 2023.*

Note: *From the session 1994-95 only candidates who have obtained a Bachelor's Degree of 10+2+3 pattern or those who have passed a one-year pre-POST Graduate/Bridge Course Examination after obtaining a Bachelor's Degree of 10+1+3 or 10+2+2 pattern shall be considered eligible for admission.*

Provided that *it would not apply in the case of such candidates who have passed their graduation examination prior to the academic session of 1991-92 and they will also have the option to clear the Pre P.G./ Bridge Course for seeking admission or appearing in the examination for a higher course in the University of elsewhere.(Academic Council Res. No. 3 dated 18/19 April 94 & Syndicate Res. No. 9 dt, 18.7.94).*

(c) Admission of Candidate with Supplementary

- (i) An applicant, who is declared eligible to appear at the Supplementary Examination in qualifying exam, is eligible for admission to next higher class on the basis of merit.
- (ii) The applicant will be provisionally admitted, at his/her own risk, to the next higher class in the beginning of the session by the last day fixed for admission subject to the conditions mentioned in the clause given below. He/she will be assumed to have secured minimum passing

marks in the subject of supplementary examination for the purpose of preparation of merit list for admission.

- (iii) A candidate who fails or absents him/her self at the Supplementary Examination shall have no right to continue in the next higher class and his/her provisional admission to the next higher class shall stand cancelled automatically.
- (d) **Age** : As per BCI norms.
- (e) **Concession** : As per University Norms provided in University Prospectus 2023-24.
- (f) **Reservation** : As per University Norms provided in University Prospectus 2023-24.

II. Admission Procedure

- (a) There are 300 seats in University Law College and 300 Seats in University Law College Centre-II.

Note: *There shall be a single form to apply for the admission to LL.B. I year in both the colleges.*

- (b) Admission to LL.B. I year on the above seats shall be made on the basis of Merit of marks obtained at entrance examination i.e. ULET-2023 and weightage mark(s) if applicable.

Note: *A candidate may apply either on the basis of UG or on the basis of PG marks whichever is higher*

- (c) From the Merit, first 300 candidates (category wise) shall be given admission to University Law College and next 300 candidates (category wise) shall be given admission to University Law College Centre-II.

However, *if a candidate of higher merit wants to take admission in University Law College Centre-II, may be considered in the merit of University Law College Centre-II on written application made to the Convener, ULET-2023 at the time of counselling of admission for University Law College.*

- (d) In case where two or more candidates stand on same merit position, the preference shall be made to the candidate on the following criteria in descending order : -

- (i) Who has secured higher marks in qualifying examination without any weightage .
- (ii) Where the merit of both the candidates are of equal PG marks, who has secured higher marks in UG;
- (iii) Where the merit of a candidate is of UG marks and another's of PG marks, who has secured higher marks in UG;
- (iv) Where the merit of both the candidates are of equal UG marks, who has secured higher marks in XII standard; and
- (v) Where either of the above criteria unable to fix the preference, who is older than other.

- (e) Reservation, weightage/concession for NCC/NSS/Sports/ Differently Abled and other category shall be given as per University Rules, subject to fulfilment of minimum eligibility criteria.

Special Note : All the grievance(s) related to Entrance Examination(ULET-2023) shall be entertained upto July 12, 2023 till 4:00 p.m. No subsequent grievance(s) on any condition shall be admitted. Decision of ULET-2023 Committee on the grievance(s) shall be final.

INFORMATION REGARDING THE ENTRANCE TEST

1. Admission to the LL.B. First year (Three Year Course) shall be on the basis of merit secured in the ULET-2023 based on the total marks scored in written test and weightage mark(s) if applicable, which will be published on the university website as per the schedule.
2. The Entrance Test is tentatively scheduled to be held on **7th July, 2023 (Friday) from 11:00 AM to 12:30 PM at different centres in Jaipur only.** The duration of the test shall be **One & half Hours.**
3. The entrance test shall have 150 Multiple Choice Questions carrying one (1) mark each. **There will be no negative marking.**
4. The Candidate shall use only Blue/Black Ball point pen during the entrance examination.
5. After completion of entrance test, the candidates can carry Question Booklet alongwith carbon copy of OMR Sheet with them.
6. The Centre for Entrance Test (ULET-2023) and Roll number will be given on admit card which will be made available on the university website as per the schedule.
7. No candidate will be permitted to enter the examination hall without the admit card and a valid photo ID card.
8. The candidates will not be allowed to enter in the Examination Hall after 10:45 a.m. sharp.
9. Carrying Mobile/Smart Phone(s), Bluetooth device(s), Smart Watch etc. in the examination hall is strictly prohibited. If any objectionable material is found, then action will be taken as per University Rules and State Government Legislation.
10. Totally blind candidates must arrange a scribe on their own and should carry attested copies of the certificate issued in accordance with Statute 17

(A) (ii). Moreover attested copies of Marks Sheet/Certificate and Photo Identity of the scribe should be submitted to the Centre Superintendent of the Entrance Test Centre at least one day prior to the entrance test. scribe should not be in higher class than 10th standard.

11. There shall be a provision for videography of the centre on the date of examination.
12. The candidate should not believe in hearsay and must seek information relating to admission only from University Website or information provided by the office Convener, ULET-2023, University Law College Centre-II, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

Syllabus & Sample Questions

- The test paper will consist of one question paper containing 150 objective type questions with multiple choice answers.
- The syllabus of the Entrance Test includes: General Knowledge, Social Science, General Science, Indian Constitution and General English.
- The sample question for the ULET-2023 will be available on the University website.
- The language of the entrance examination will be Hindi & English.

Note : In case of any discrepancy in the English and Hindi Version of the Question Paper, the English Version shall be treated as valid.

Answer Key

1. The University shall publish the Answer Key pertaining to ULET-2023 on the University website as per the schedule.
2. Any objection with reference to Answer Key/Questions in the ULET-2023 may be submitted in writing to the **Convener, ULET-2023, University Law College Centre-II, University of Rajasthan, Jaipur** as per the schedule till 4:00 p.m. on 12-7-2023.
